Suggested basket shapes are

roughly 7 x 7 short basket that holds paper napkins— these are typically short baskets (3-4 in tall) and will take less time.

Roughly 5 x 9 basket that can be a tote or hold a box of Kleenex. These baskets are typically taller 5-7 in. and can take a bit longer to weave. Of course these baskets can be used for anything else as well. The intermediate basket makers can add handles to their baskets. Roughly 7x7x7 in "taller" basket that may be round or square.
